

### FASTING GUIDE

Over the course of these 21 Days of Prayer, many will find it important to fast during this intentional period of time. It is not something that is required, but some see it as a way to dedicate their physical, mental, and spiritual self to prayer. Below is a short guide for those considering fasting:

### What is Fasting?

The goal of fasting is to draw near to God. Biblical fasting always has to do with eliminating distractions for a spiritual purpose. Fasting is a way to express our desire for God and our holy discontent in a fallen world. Remember, your personal fast should present a level of challenge, but it is very important to know your body, your options, and most importantly, to seek God in prayer and follow what the Holy Spirit leads you to do.

### Types of Fasts:

### Complete Fast

In this type of fast, you drink only liquids, typically water with light juices as an option.

### Selective Fast

This type of fast involves removing certain elements from your diet. One example of a selective fast is the Daniel Fast, during which you remove meat, sweets, and bread from your diet and consume water and juice for fluids and fruits and vegetables for food.

### Partial Fast

This fast is sometimes called the "Jewish Fast" and involves abstaining from eating any type of food in the morning and afternoon. This can either correlate to specific times of the day, such as 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., or from sunup to sundown.

### Non-Food Fast

This fast is a great option if you do not have much experience fasting from food, have health issues that prevent you from fasting from food, or if you wish to refocus certain areas of your life that are out of balance. For example, you might choose to stop using social media or watching television for the duration of the fast and then carefully bring that element back into your life in healthy doses at the conclusion of the fast.



Over the next 21 days, we will unite in prayer as a church, because prayer is the foundation for everything that we do. We believe in the vision that God has entrusted to us – a vision of people knowing God, finding freedom, discovering purpose, and making the difference they were created to make.

Each day we will focus on one area that God is leading us to invest our time, passion, and influence during this next season. They are more than events or ministries, but opportunities for lives to be changed. Families will have their stories redeemed. People will walk free from addictions. Students will discover purpose. Kids will fall into love with Jesus. Every life that God changes through Freedom Church begins here with 21 Days of Prayer.

Each day, you will find our prayer focus with a scripture, worship song, and a scripted prayer. During these 21 days, we invite you to pray together as one church from your homes, your cars, your work place, or wherever you decide to pray that day.

We pray our prayer lives will grow as we discover new depths of prayer from one another. You are a vital part to what God is doing through New Hope Chapel. The investment of prayer you make the next 21 days is going to change everything for someone. You are going to be part of someone's story of redemption, hope, healing, and freedom.
